Caleb: Hi! I love the tennis courts. I wanted to know about the bleachers there. I was wondering if there are plans for the quads with water filling station.

Tim: I am not sure if those will become permanent. We place them when there is a tournament. For the quads if we do anything to any building it is the water filling stations. We are looking into the quads right now and studying what they need. They are a great location and we are looking into ore beds in that area.

Molly: I was wondering if you have plans for plastic use in dining halls.

Tim: I think Scott is better at answering these questions. But the green trays are great and are steps towards limiting plastic use. It's great that people are using this and filling them up. Yes there is talk on this but Scott would be better to tell you this.

Lili: Is there a way we could get student IDs to connect to phones for scanning into buildings and dining?

Tim: Virtual ID is definitely something we want coming. It is the next generation opening doors to many options.

Ty: One other thing. In the resident halls, there is no first aid kit. I feel like this would be good for when stupid things occur and when someone gets hurt.

Tim: I will definitely talk and see how we could go about doing this. We partner with Cayuga Med so we will talk to them about this.
