Common Questions that are Asked:

******please note that there might be questions that are asked that are not on this sheet, questions are just a chance so the committee can know your organization more 😊**

- General:
 - Is the requesting organization recognized?
 - Has the requesting individual attended a workshop?
 - Has the requesting organization met/received the approval of their advisor for the request?
- Travel/Conferences
 - How are the people attending the conference chosen?
 - How many people attending are e-board members?
- Programming
 - How many people do you anticipate attending the event?
 - What strategies do you intend to use to reach people to attend the event?
 - Is this event open to all of Ithaca College?
 - Where will the event take place? Will people need to RSVP?
 - Will the speaker be doing a presentation, debate, leading a decision, etc.?
 - What is the content that they will be discussing?
 - Has the speaker been in national news? If yes, for what?
 - How do you prepare to handle any protests?
 - Have you thought to supply space in case of any protests?
 - Will this event need any additional security?
 - Will the speaker require additional insurance?
 - Are you aware of the new policy between SGC and OSE to put all programming events on Engage and post the events to the Public Calendar?
- Fundraising
 - What is organization raising funds for?
 - What strategies will your organization be taking in order to raise enough funds to repay this loan (if approved) and make a profit?
 - Do you have an account or access to receive money from individuals during the virtual semester? (such as having a venmo account?)
- Operational
 - How do these requested items associate with the day to day operations of your organization?
