5:00pm today, 9/29, is the Grace Period deadline for returning Student Organizations. After today, those who have not completed Re-Recognition will not have access to the privileges of being Recognized with OSE, including requesting and spending money and making and holding room reservations.

If you have not completed the process yet, you can still work towards Re-Recognition! The final Re-Recognition deadline for the 2023-2024 academic year is Friday, December 8th, 2023.

Steps for Recognition

- #1: Fill out IC Engage Form**
The Form was emailed to all Organization Primary Contacts. If you did not receive an email, please contact Sarah Boniche, the Associate Director for Student Involvement, at sboniche@ithaca.edu.
On this form, you will update your Org's IC Engage profile and roster and create an updated Constitution.
- #2: Review the Handbook**
After form approval, 4 Designated Officers should review the NEW Student Organization Handbook. The Handbook can be found on the OSE website.
- #3: Take the Officers' Quiz**
Once the 4 Designated Officers have reviewed the Handbook they are ready to take and pass the Officers' Quiz. This will be emailed directly to the Officers.
- #4: Attend a Leading @ IC SLI**
Leading @ IC SLIs help Student Organization Officers learn leadership and professional skills, as well as ways to effectively perform in their role.
The 4 Designated Officers must attend 1 Leading @ IC SLI before the Grace Period Deadline of 9/30/2023. Please refer to our website for an alternative option.
